### Attendance Requirements ~ Hi, I'm doing learning today 😕

Each child enrolled at Mother Teresa PS is required to engage in learning each day and to indicate that they are doing this daily.

In order for us to mark attendance each child is required to 'check in' each morning by sending their contact teachers an email –'Good Morning Ms... I am engaging in learning today'. If your child does not check in you will be contacted during the day.
